Limited Attendance: Only Scouts of First Class or higher ranks from the Seven Rivers District and Bellingham Troop 1 may register. All Scouts **must** pre-register. There will be no on-site (Walk-in) registrations. Register early, as classes will fill rapidly on a first-come-first-served basis. Class size is limited and some classes are extremely small. Each Scout must fill out a separate registration form. In order to be considered, the form must be filled out completely, signed by the Scoutmaster and the proper fees attached. Due to the significant costs in financing this event, there will be no refunds issued whatsoever for any reason.

The total fee is \$20.00 per Scout if you register by Jan. 19, 2007. After Jan. 19th the fee is \$25.00 per person. This fee includes three merit badge pamphlets and an event patch. Extra event patches must be preordered and purchased for \$2.00 each. All registration forms and fees must be received at the Old Colony Council no later than Friday February 2, 2007.
