### Directions for Scouts:

**Step 1:** Complete the Contact Information section (at right).

**Step 3:** In the "Rate" column, rate the priority of 12 merit badge course selections with a priority number (from 1 to 12, with 1 being the most important to you and 12 being the least important to you. Set to 13 for no priority).

**Step 4:** Return this form to your scoutmaster as soon as possible. Your scoutmaster will submit your troop's online MBU registration through the Council website during the week of **January 16-21, 2011**.

## FAQ for Scouts Regarding Merit Badge Selections

### ***Why can't I sign-up for merit badges when I arrive at MBU?***

To make sure that sufficient counselors, class space, and course materials are available, the MBU staff needs participants to register in advance. There will be NO on-site registration at MBU.

### ***Why can't I change merit badge selections when I arrive at MBU?***

To support classes and advancement tracking a great deal of pre-MBU planning and paperwork is prepared. The MBU staff needs to focus on providing the planned courses for the registered participants at MBU. It is just not possible to support dynamic course selections on-site. There will be NO merit badge selection changes allowed on the first day of MBU.

### ***What are the deadlines for MBU registration?***

Old Colony Council troops will receive their MBU registration packets at the January 2011 district round table meetings. At some point during the month of January your troop will hold a registration night, so you may complete and submit your merit badge selections to your scoutmaster. Your Scoutmaster will submit your troop's online MBU registration through the Council website during the week of January 16-21, 2011.

### ***Why does the MBU sign-up form ask for 12 merit badge selections when I'm only taking three merit badge classes at MBU?***

The MBU form asks for your 12 choices because scouts receive their classes based on a priority system (not a "first troop to register" system). **Each scout selections are prioritized by:** (1) Is a parent/guardian serving as an MBU counselor, (2) scout rank, (3) scout age, and (4) priority order of merit badge selections. So, a scout who: has a parent serving as a counselor and has a higher rank and is older does have a better chance of getting his top three merit badge selections.

### ***Why does the First Aid merit badge take 2 hours at each MBU session?***

The First Aid merit badge requires a lot of "hands-on" practice and demonstration. This course is provided in a 2 hour format to give counselors and scouts sufficient time to cover the material and give scouts a better chance of completing the merit badge at MBU.

### ***What is the Flight-to-Eagle program at MBU?***

To make MBU more appealing to new, younger scouts (first year scouts and Webelos who have crossed over from Pack to Troop before MBU), the MBU Flight-to-Eagle program teaches many of the Tenderfoot rank requirements. This program is coordinated with the Camp Squanto summer camp Flight-to-Eagle program. Typically, the MBU program focuses on requirements that are not covered at camp.

### ***It's my first time at MBU. What merit badges should I select?***

For your first time at MBU, you might want to select badges with less potential homework and a greater possibility of completion. The MBU staff recommends Art, Bird Study, Crime Prevention, Dog Care, Medicine, Reading, Space Exploration, and Sports as good possibilities for first time MBU attendees.
